Course Description/Rationale:

The Grade 10 course provides opportunity for students to explore and to further develop their artistic and creative processes. Students make connections between works of art and their historical context. Units are organized according to themes that reflect issues that are relevant to students as individuals, and as artists. Students produce works designed around specific objectives with an overall theme unifying them which demonstrates the ability to take varied and creative approaches to using materials, tools, processes, and technologies in studio activities. Students will analyze their artwork critically and describe the relationship between art and the community.
