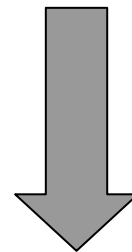
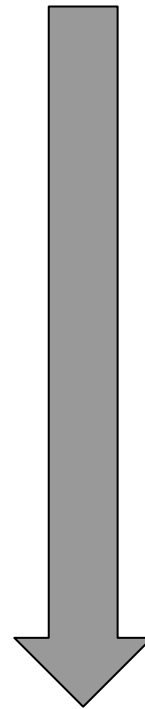
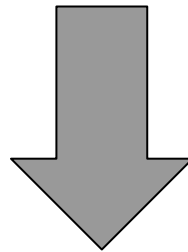
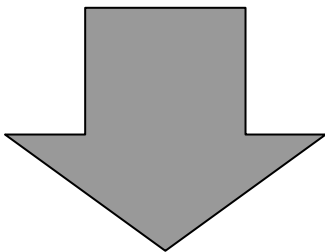




# HOW TO READ COURSE CODES:

Every course in an Ontario Secondary School has a 5 or 6 character course code.

# SNC 1 L 1



**The first 3 letters represent the course's department and subject:**

A = Arts  
B = Business  
C = Canadian & World Studies  
E = English  
G = Guidance & Career Education  
H = Humanities & Social Sciences  
M = Mathematics  
N = Native Studies  
P = Physical Education  
S = Sciences  
T = Technology

**Number or letter shows grade level**

1 = 9  
2 = 10  
3 = 11  
4 = 12

Sometimes a letter or number is used to distinguish one course from another. For example, in this case the 1 indicates a class for grade 9 students only

**Letter shows course level**

**Grade 9 & 10**

P = Applied  
L = Locally Developed  
O = Open

**Grade 11 & 12**

C = College  
E = Workplace  
O = Open
