RE: **Playstructure and Playground Funding Allocation - Form 700  
Submission 2015/16**

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The Ottawa-Carleton District School Board approved a \$300,000 initiative, for a second year, as part of the 2015-2016 Budget for playgrounds and playstructures. This funding was intended to assist school communities with the development and renewal of their playstructures and school grounds.

Applicants that did not receive funding last year were placed on the evaluation list along with any new updates since their last request. Schools were advised of the Form 700 process again this year, which resulted in new applications for consideration. All these projects were ranked and prioritized, along with the revised submissions received across the District.

We would like to thank all of the school communities who submitted an application for funding. The value of project applications that were submitted for consideration, by the School Operations Committee (SOC), exceeded the current allocation. Unfortunately, not all submissions could be approved at this time. There were 15 active applications reviewed with 12 schools being successful.
